Position Requirements

What are we looking for in our School-year Program Staff?

During the Best Delegate Fall hiring cycle, we are looking to hire qualified mentors and chairs to staff our programs from October 2021-April 2022. All positions are virtual.

Qualifications:

- Currently attending or recently graduated from a university with a strong Model UN program.
- Minimum age of applicants is 18 years old.
- Must be a citizen or resident of the United States or Canada.
- Be able to pass a background check.

Model UN Experience

- Experience with classroom teaching or lesson planning is highly preferred.
- Experience training a travel team is also preferred.
- Experience chairing committees as a university or high school student and expertise in standard North American procedure is required.
- Past experience as a participant in Best Delegate Programing or in the North America high school circuit, particularly for a top-ranked travel team, is a plus.

Competencies

- Understands how to deliver a high quality educational experience to students.
- Ability to explain complex concepts in simple, organized frameworks and formulas.
- Research, writing, and editing skills must be at an advanced university level.
- Comfortable providing honest feedback and mentoring to students.
- Willingness to put in the extra effort to ensure the program is as successful as possible.

MUN Teams Coach

Coach the next generation of Model UN Superstars!

The Model UN Team Coach position is a 10-week mentorship opportunity for top university students or graduates with significant Model UN training experience, leadership experience, and interest in educating the next generation of student leaders. Model UN Teams are exactly what they sound like! Students will practice their public speaking skills, build their confidence, and make new friends as they help fellow MUN Team members prepare to represent different countries and debate about real world issues at Model UN conferences.

It's similar to being on a private sports team where students from different schools get together and compete for awards at national Model United Nations conferences. Any student can join, even if they are already part of their school's MUN club, to gain additional training and leadership experience that they can bring back to their school's MUN club!

Model UN Team Coaches will be responsible for:

- Preparing for and professionally coaching 1-hour Team Meetings each week utilizing a predetermined curriculum designed by Best Delegate
- Providing individual feedback to your students following each conference
- Facilitating a fun and educational environment through mentoring
- Ensuring a safe environment for all students in your team at all times
- Creating a great experience for the students in your Team, as shown through high student feedback scores

Program Dates & Times

When Applying to become a MUN Teams Coach, staff **must** be available for the following program deliverables:

- Staff Training (First or Second Week in October)
- 1 Hour per week for online delivery of the MUN Team program from the week of **October 18th December 6th & January 10th-January 23rd** (Staff will be given an opportunity to indicate age and experience preference)
- 6 hours on either **Saturday or Sunday of both the Nov 20th and January 15th** to observe students (see application form for more details)
- Monthly Team Meetings

If Staff are unable to meet any of the above requirements, they should indicate such in the application form "notes" section. Inability to meet these requirements will not disqualify candidates but may reduce their chance of being selected.

BDMUNC Staff will be responsible for:

- Preparing for and professionally leading one day committees utilizing a predetermined curriculum designed by Best Delegate
- Providing overall feedback for the delegate's in your committee
- Ensuring a safe environment for all students at the conference at all times
- Creating a great experience for your committee, as shown through high student feedback scores

Work 1:1 with students to bring out their very best!

Private Coaches for Best Delegate's 1:1 sessions have the opportunity to help motivated students prepare in depth for Model UN Conferences. These might be virtual Best Delegate Conference or even large High School conferences their schools are attending. Staff will work with a predetermined curriculum to help delegates work on public speaking, resolution writing, crisis archs, and more!

Private Coaches will be responsible for:

- Preparing for and professionally leading 1:1 sessions utilizing a predetermined curriculum designed by Best Delegate
- Providing overall feedback for the delegate during your session
- Ensuring a safe environment for your delegates at all times
- Adapting and adjusting sessions to challenge your delegates and bring out the best

Program Dates & Times

When Applying to become a Private Coach, staff **must** be available for the following program deliverables:

- Staff Training (First or Second Week in October)
- At minimum, 3 hours of private coaching (4 x 45 minute sessions) per week from September 24th, 2021-April 15th, 2022
 - o Month of December will be optional
- Monthly Team Meetings
- Optional: Staff bonding, socials & professional development trainings

If Staff are unable to meet any of the above requirements, they should indicate such in the application form "notes" section. Inability to meet these requirements will not disqualify candidates but may reduce their chance of being selected.

Compensation:

- \$60 per 4x45 minute session (3 hours total)
- One time \$40 training stipend
